Inauguration ceremony of "Free Health Checkup camp" was done from 10:10 AM to 10:40 AM. The introductory note was given by Shri. Ravsaheb Babasaheb Patil & his team heartly welcomed Hospital Staff of AMAHRC. Then Dr. Girish Kumar V guided the villagers on Health Issues, following which camp started at 10:40 AM continued till 03:00 PM with Screening of 93 patients of various Health conditions.

Different Stages of CAMP

1.Registration: -

Registration was done by following all the norms of covid-19 prevention like maintaining social distance, hand sanitization and wearing mask. Patient who came without mask were given mask at free of cost. (Around 40 masks were given)

2.Screening: -

Patients were screened for various Health condition by asking them initial symptoms along with checking BP, SPO₂, Pulse & Body Temperature.


3. Consultation: -

Separate three OPD's two for male and one for female respectively were formed in which detailed systemic examination of patients was conducted. Total 93 number of patients Health checkup was done. Which had Male 58 and Female 35 in patients.

The patients were arrived with sign and symptoms of Vaatvyadhis like Katigatvaat, Aamvaat, Sandhigatvaat, Ghrudhrasi etc. Twakvikar, Digestive system disorder like Ajirn, Amlpitta etc., also female disorders like White Discharge, UTI, PCOD. Based on their clinical symptoms and diagnosis, Ayurvedic as well as Allopathy treatment was advised by the doctors.

4. Medicine Dispensing: -

The Ayurvedic Medicine dispensed were in different dosage forms like Vati, Gutika, Tail, Asav, Arishta, Churna etc. The Medicines were given at Free of Cost which costs approximately 25 to 33 thousand Rupees & Allopathy Medicines like Tablet, Syrup etc. around 5 thousand Rupees.



The Organizers felicitated Hospital Staff by giving flower bouquet. The Organizers and patient were happy with the camp and the way it was conducted. The village people and organizers also requested to conduct the follow-up camps on a monthly & bi-monthly basis along with different specialties.
